DOS/ISRO reserves the right not to fill-up the post, if it so decides. Only Indian nationals working in DOS/ISRO need to apply. There is no specified format for the application. All eligible scientists/engineers of DOS/ISRO may send their applications to Additional Secretary, DOS, along with detailed curriculum vitae and with the remarks/recommendations of their Centre Director by 22/04/2016. The applications can be sent only by post or courier. There is no provision for sending the application either online or through e-mail.
