

Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO), Department of Space (DOS), Government of India, invites Expression of Interest (EOI) from reputed publishers for publication, distribution, marketing, digital dissemination and rights management of several Books/Booklets authored by ISRO/DOS Scientists and Engineers. The purpose is to identify capable publishing partners with strong editorial, production, distribution and digital publishing capabilities.

IMPORTANT NOTE:

NO-COST, NO-ROYALTY ENGAGEMENT: This is a no-cost, no-royalty engagement. ISRO/DOS shall not pay any fee, charge or consideration to the Publisher, and the Publisher shall not pay any royalty, revenue share or any other consideration to ISRO/DOS or to the author(s). The Publisher shall bear all costs of design, editing, production, printing, digital conversion, promotion/advertisement/marketing and distribution entirely at its own risk and expense, and shall be entitled to retain the entire proceeds from the sale of the books/booklets, subject strictly to the pricing, reporting and compliance obligations set out in this EOI.

This EOI does NOT constitute a commitment to award any contract. ISRO/DOS reserves the right to accept, reject or modify any submission without assigning any reason and without incurring any financial liability to respondents.

1. BACKGROUND INFORMATION

As part of the ISROs' outreach programme, ISRO/DOS has initiated a programme to communicate space science, space technology, space applications, exploration missions, launch vehicles, observatories, human spaceflight and India's contributions to space activities in a form accessible to students and citizens. Practising Scientists and Engineers of ISRO/DOS at its Centres, Units and Autonomous Bodies have authored popular and semi-popular level books and booklets on space science and technology for secondary school, high school and undergraduate-level students.

The books/booklets will cover (not limited to):

- Space science and exploration and related technologies
- Ground observatories, observation platforms and space transportation systems
- Enabling technologies for future space exploration
- Space science data archival and science from human spaceflight
- Space applications

1.1 Mandate and Programme Objectives

Objectives include widening access to authentic scientific knowledge in a lucid language, strengthening science communication, enabling multilingual dissemination, encouraging educational use, and creating sustainable publication and distribution mechanisms.

1.2 Nature and Purpose of This EOI

This EOI is issued by Indian Space Research Organisation Headquarters to:

- Shortlist a panel of eligible publishers based on the criteria defined in this EOI.
- Invite interest from eligible publishers for publishing books and booklets, entirely at the publisher's own commercial risk and cost.
- Rigorously assess the capability to deliver the published books and booklets in-time bound manner, financial strength, distribution reach, production infrastructure and integrity of interested publishers against stringent, non-negotiable eligibility and selection criteria.
- Directly select and contract the most suitable publisher(s) on the basis of this EOI. No separate RFP stage shall follow.

2. SCOPE OF WORK

The selected publisher(s) shall provide developmental editing, copyediting, proofreading, design, illustration management, typesetting, ISBN assignment, printing, warehousing, inventory management, distribution, e-book conversion, metadata management, marketing and rights management as detailed below:

2.1 Publication of Books / Booklets

- a. Copy-editing, proof-reading, layout design and typesetting of manuscripts as per ISRO/DOS guidelines.
- b. Cover design, illustrations and infographics in consultation with ISRO/DOS.
- c. High-quality printing of physical copies.
- d. ISBN registration and cataloguing for each title.
- e. Formatting, printing and binding specifications: **As per standard specifications.**
- f. **Type of publications: Books and booklets.**
- g. E-book creation in ePub / Kindle formats.

2.2 Distribution

- a. Should have distribution network in metro cities through bookstores, book fairs, educational institutions and online retail platforms.
- b. Institutional supply to school/college libraries in coordination with Central/State education departments.

2.3 Multilingual Publishing

Capability for publication in Indian regional languages if required.

3. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

The following are the eligibility criteria which has to be met by the prospective publisher(s).

3.1 Eligibility Criteria

All the above eligibility criteria shall be supported with requisite documentary proofs, duly certified. ISRO reserves right to verify the above criteria by visiting the publishers' site.

3.2 General Terms and Conditions

4. SUBMISSION INSTRUCTIONS

4.1 Last Date and Mode

EOI responses must be submitted in physical form (hard copy) only by 23.07.2026 (15:00 hrs IST). Submission of EOI in electronic form will not be accepted.

4.3 Format Requirements

- Response in English (bilingual English/Hindi acceptable). All documents self-attested by the authorised signatory.
- Physical: spiral-bound or file-bound with section tabs.

4.4 Queries

Written queries, if any, shall be forwarded to ibwc@isro.gov.in with subject '**Query – EOI for Publishing of Books/Booklets**', minimum 7 working days before the last date.

5. GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

5.1 EOI Process & General Disclaimers

- a. ISRO/DOS is not bound to select any respondent and reserves the right to cancel, withdraw, amend or re-issue this EOI at any stage, without liability to any respondent and without assigning any reason.

- b. ISRO/DOS shall not be liable for any cost incurred by any respondent in preparing or submitting its EOI response.
- c. Submission of a response constitutes unconditional and irrevocable acceptance of every term and condition in this EOI. ISRO/DOS's selection decision, once communicated, shall be final and binding on the selected Publisher; no renegotiation of the no-cost, no-royalty basis or the stringent eligibility/performance clauses shall be entertained post-selection.
- d. EOI responses shall remain valid and binding for 180 days from the last date of submission.

5.2 No-Cost, No-Royalty Basis

- a. This is strictly a no-cost, no-royalty engagement. ISRO/DOS shall not pay the Publisher any fee, honorarium, reimbursement or other consideration whatsoever for editorial, production, printing, digital-conversion or distribution services.
- b. The Publisher shall not seek, demand or receive any royalty, revenue share, licence fee or any other monetary consideration from ISRO/DOS or from the author(s) in connection with the sale of the books/booklets.
- c. The Publisher shall bear all costs and risks of publication entirely on its own account and shall be entitled to retain the entire proceeds of sale of the books/booklets, subject strictly to the pricing finalized in consultation with ISRO/DOS.
- d. For the avoidance of doubt, nothing in this EOI or any resultant agreement shall be construed as creating any payment obligation, in either direction, between ISRO/DOS and the Publisher.

5.3 Verification, Integrity & Disqualification

- a. ISRO/DOS reserves the right to verify, including through site inspection, third-party reference checks and statutory database checks (GST portal, MCA portal, CAG empanelment lists), the authenticity of every document and claim submitted.
- b. Any misrepresentation, suppression of material fact, or submission of forged/fabricated documents shall result in immediate and irrevocable disqualification, forfeiture of any Performance Security furnished, blacklisting from future ISRO/DOS procurement for a minimum of 5 years, and may attract criminal action under the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, and the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988.
- c. The Code of Integrity applies strictly and without exception. Respondents must not offer, solicit or accept any bribe, gift or favour; must not engage in bid rigging, collusion, cartelisation or misrepresentation; and must disclose any conflict of interest immediately upon becoming aware of it.
- d. No canvassing or attempt to influence any ISRO/DOS official, committee member or evaluator, directly or indirectly, shall be permitted. Any such attempt shall result in immediate and permanent disqualification of the respondent.

5.4 Copyright, Licensing & Intellectual Property

- a. Copyright of all the books/booklets published under this EOI shall vest with ISRO.
- b. The Publisher shall be granted an exclusive right to print, publish, distribute and sell the work, for a period of FIVE (05) years for both print and digital versions within India and extendable further by mutually agreed timeline.
- c. The Publisher shall not sub-licence, assign or transfer any rights granted to it to any third party without the prior written consent of ISRO/DOS.
- d. Content shall not be altered, abridged or modified in any manner without prior written approval of ISRO/DOS and the respective author(s).
- e. ISRO's logo, name and visual identity shall be used on covers and promotional material strictly in accordance with ISRO's guidelines.

5.5 Author Attribution & Editorial Control

- a. The Publisher shall ensure that the name(s) of the author(s) as specified by ISRO/DOS are prominently credited on the cover, title page, and all digital editions of each book/booklet.
- b. No editorial changes that would misrepresent the author's views or damage the author's reputation shall be made without the prior written approval of ISRO/DOS and the concerned author(s).
- c. The Publisher shall not sub-licence, adapt, translate, or abridge any work without prior written approval of ISRO/DOS, and any permitted translation shall carry the same author attribution.
- d. ISRO/DOS acknowledges that books and booklets are authored by practising Scientists and Engineers in good faith as a public outreach contribution, and not in a commercial capacity. The ISRO/DOS personnel behind the titles, in all capacities, shall not be held liable for inadvertent factual inaccuracies, technical errors, or omissions made in good faith. Upon identification of any inadvertent error, the Publisher shall, within 30 (thirty) days of written notification by ISRO/DOS, issue a corrigendum or errata sheet, update all digital editions, and where a reprint is due, incorporate the correction.
- e. The Publisher shall indemnify and hold harmless the Author(s), officials involved in the process of reviews and publishing and ISRO/DOS from any claims, liabilities, or legal proceedings arising from the Publisher's acts or omissions in the printing, distribution, or commercial exploitation of the books/booklets.
- f. ISRO/DOS has subjected all books/booklets published under this campaign to a multi-tier review process and affirms, to the best of its knowledge and belief, that the scientific and technical content presented therein is original in expression. Any incidental similarity between portions of the content and publicly available material shall be limited to generic concepts, established scientific principles, or domain-specific terminology that are, by their nature, common to the field and shall not constitute plagiarism or infringement of any third party's intellectual property rights. The Publisher shall not be held liable for any such incidental similarity, provided that the content has been published without alteration from the manuscript approved by ISRO/DOS.

5.6 Performance Security

- a. The successful Publisher(s) shall, within 15 days of the Letter of Selection/Award, furnish an unconditional and irrevocable Performance Security of Rs. 5,00,000 (Rupees Five Lakhs only), from a Scheduled Commercial Bank, valid till 60 days beyond expiry of contract period.
- b. The Performance Security shall be forfeited, in whole or in part, in the event of any material breach, including but not limited to: failure to meet delivery timelines, failure to maintain pricing as finalized in consultation with ISRO/DOS or breach of the Code of Integrity.
- c. Failure to furnish the Performance Security within the stipulated period shall be treated as withdrawal by the Publisher, entitling ISRO/DOS to annul the selection and select the next publisher as per ISRO's discretion, in addition to other remedies available in law.

5.7 Delivery Timelines & Liquidated Damages

- a. All books/booklets should be published within 60 days from the date of providing the finalized manuscript by ISRO; physical copies shall be dispatched to ISRO HQ within 30 days of approval of final proofs.
- b. Delay beyond the timeline shall attract liquidated damages of 0.5% of the estimated print value of first edition of the delayed title per week of delay, subject to a

maximum of 5%, without prejudice to ISRO/DOS's right to terminate the contract.

5.8 Pricing, Stock & Distribution

- a. The Publisher shall maintain a minimum stock of 50 copies per title at all times during the contract period.
- b. The MRP of each physical book/booklet shall be decided in consultation with ISRO/DOS.
- c. Institutional/bulk supply to schools, colleges and government libraries shall be offered at a minimum discount of 20% on MRP.
- d. The Publisher shall supply, free of charge and at its own cost, a minimum of 100 copies of each title assigned to them to ISRO HQ for distribution, promotional and archival purposes, within 15 days of first print.
- e. ISRO/DOS may support at its own discretion the selected publisher(s) in promoting the books/booklets through its outreach activities without any financial commitments.

5.9 Contract Duration & Termination

- a. The initial engagement period shall be FIVE (05) year from the date of execution of the Publishing Agreement and extendable further by mutually agreed timeline on the same no-cost, no-royalty terms.
- b. ISRO/DOS may terminate the Publishing Agreement with 30 days written notice for any material breach not remedied within the notice period, with forfeiture of the Performance Security as applicable. Either party may terminate without cause on 90 days written notice.
- c. Upon termination or expiry, all publishing rights granted to the Publisher shall revert to ISRO/DOS with immediate effect, and the Publisher shall cease all further printing, sale and distribution within 30 days, save for liquidation of existing lawfully printed stock.

5.10 Confidentiality & Data Protection

- a. All unpublished manuscripts, editorial communications, and any data shared by ISRO/DOS shall be treated as strictly confidential, used solely for the purposes of this engagement, and shall not be disclosed to any third party without ISRO/DOS's prior written consent.
- b. Data Protection and Confidentiality of Manuscripts: All unpublished manuscripts, author data, scientific content, editorial correspondence, and any information shared by ISRO/DOS or its authors shall be treated as strictly confidential. The Publisher shall implement reasonable technical and organisational measures to prevent unauthorised access, copying, or disclosure of such material.
- c. The confidentiality obligation shall survive termination or expiry of the Publishing Agreement for a period of FIVE (05) years.
- d. The Publisher shall promptly notify ISRO/DOS of any actual or suspected data breach, loss, or unauthorised disclosure within 48 hours of becoming aware of such an event and shall take all necessary actions to prevent further loss of data.
- e. The Publisher under any circumstances shall not input, upload, submit, or otherwise disclose any published, unpublished manuscript, author data, scientific content, editorial correspondence, or any other confidential information shared by ISRO/DOS into any artificial intelligence (AI) tool, large language model (LLM), AI-powered platform, or any third-party automated processing system or social media, whether cloud-based or otherwise. Breach of this clause shall constitute a material breach of the Publishing Agreement, entitling ISRO/DOS to immediate termination and forfeiture of the Performance Security, without prejudice to any other legal remedies available.

5.11 Anti-Piracy & Enforcement

- a. The Publisher shall promptly report any instance of piracy, copyright infringement or unauthorised reproduction to ISRO/DOS and shall cooperate fully, at its own cost, in any anti-piracy action.
- b. Anti-Piracy and Enforcement Mechanism: The Publisher shall actively monitor the market for piracy, unauthorised reproduction, and counterfeit copies of the books/booklets. Upon detecting any such infringement, the Publisher shall: (a) notify ISRO/DOS in writing within TWO (02) working days; (b) take immediate steps to report the infringement to relevant authorities (police, customs, e-commerce platforms) at the Publisher's own cost; (c) cooperate fully with ISRO/DOS in any civil or criminal proceedings, including providing evidence and appearing as a witness if required. ISRO/DOS shall retain the right to take independent legal action for infringement of copyright vested in it.

5.12 Liability & Force Majeure

- a. Neither Party shall be liable for any delay or failure in performance of its obligations under the Publishing Agreement to the extent such delay or failure is caused by circumstances beyond its reasonable control, including acts of God, natural disasters, pandemics, government-imposed restrictions, strikes not caused by that Party, or war ("Force Majeure Event"). The affected Party shall promptly notify the other in writing upon becoming aware of such an event.
- b. If a Force Majeure Event continues for more than Sixty (60) consecutive days, either Party may terminate the Publishing Agreement with Thirty (30) days' written notice, without liability, save for obligations already accrued prior to the Force Majeure Event.

5.13 Dispute Resolution & Governing Law

- a. Disputes shall first be subject to good-faith negotiation for 30 days. If unresolved, disputes shall be referred to arbitration under the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996, with the sole arbitrator appointed by ISRO/DOS and the seat of arbitration at Bengaluru. The arbitral award shall be final and binding. Cost of arbitration shall be equally shared by both the parties or as decided by the Arbitration.
- b. This EOI and any resultant agreement shall be governed by the laws of India, and courts at Bengaluru, Karnataka, shall have exclusive jurisdiction.

6. EVALUATION AND SELECTION PROCESS

6.1 Stage 1 - Screening

Only those publishers who meet the eligibility criteria in Section 3 of this EOI will be considered for **Stage 2** evaluation.

6.2 Stage 2 - Evaluation (100 Marks)

A minimum qualifying score of 70/100 is required for selection. Among respondents scoring 70 or above, ISRO/DOS shall select the highest-scoring respondent(s); ISRO/DOS may select more than one Publisher at its sole discretion.

The decision of ISRO/DOS shall be final and binding. Individual scores shall not be disclosed to respondents. Selected Publisher(s) shall be issued a Letter of Selection, followed by execution of a Publishing Agreement incorporating all terms of this EOI.

"Expression of Interest" with all essential information shall reach the Head Purchase and Stores, Purchase Section, ISRO Head Quarters, Antariksh Bhavan, New BEL Road, Bengaluru, 560 094, on or before 23.07.2026 15:00 Hrs.

Inadequate or incomplete information will result in rejection of the offer. ISRO HQ reserves the right to accept or reject all or any of the EOI. Mere compliance to the EOI terms does not guarantee further consideration for qualification. Also, ISRO HQ reserves the right to hold pre-bid meeting/seek clarifications with all the parties or with some of the parties, on need basis.
