

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

1. Clarification sought on the statement 'The payload capacity of the proposed satellite is likely to be ~100 kg with ~500W of power'

The total payload mass is ~100 kg (mass of both Indian and international payloads together).

2. Is there any limit on the total number of pages allowed for the proposal?

The total number of pages is limited to 40 excluding executive summary.

This AO has a specific objective to identify important science experiments that strengthens and / or complements overall science from the suite of pre-selected proposals from India.

We seek new payload proposals which will strengthen the overall science as well as joint payload proposals which will complement the overall science.
